

## Call for Abstract

The 32<sup>nd</sup> RSM-2020 invites abstracts for paper presentation from doctoral students, who have completed at least two years of research, from the date of registration. The RSM-2020 also calls for poster presentation from post graduate students. The students who are pursuing M.Sc. Degree, and completed 1 year of course from University, affiliated colleges or autonomous colleges/universities in Mumbai are eligible for poster presentation at RSM-2020.

The abstracts for paper/poster presentations should be limited to 300 words and must highlight the research work. It should specify the name of the research scholar (presenting scholar only) and of the research guide(s). Please use the word processor (MS Word) with the following settings: A4 size (11.69" × 8.27"): margins of 1.5" on left and 1" on all other sides; font Times New Roman: line spacing 1.5 lines and spacing after para 6 pt; line1: title in capital, bold and in 14 point font size; line2: author's name (underlined) and name of research guide (asterisk); line3: email ids; line4: name of affiliated institution; line5: body of abstract in font size 12; keywords (maximum 6) to be mentioned at the end of body; references (2 no.) have to be included in following format:

Anjali Mer, Rajesh Samant and Prabha Padmanambha, Intl. J. Adv. Chem. 6 (2018) 1-7..

All abstracts will be reviewed by technical committee and short-listed candidates will be informed by email. It is mandatory for the concerned research supervisor to be available at the time of presentation.

## RSM

Research Scholars' Meet (RSM) is an important event of Indian Chemical Society (Mumbai Branch). It provides a platform to Ph.D. students to present their work and showcase themselves in front of experts of Chemical Sciences. Research scholars registered for doctoral program can present and discuss their work to get valuable suggestions from experts in the field. Interaction among the students, scientists and teachers from BARC, TIFR, IITB, UM, ICT, CEBS and colleges affiliated to Mumbai University is expected to be scientifically fruitful.

### Indian Chemical Society (ICS)
