National Level Conferences :

A number of Seminars and Conferences were organized by the IQAC in association with the various departments and committees of the college. Some of these were :

- The IQAC conducted a Two-Day National Level Seminar sponsored by NAAC on the theme "Envisioning Effective Strategies for Administrative and Academic Audit " on 27th and 28th February 2017. The aim of the Seminar was to smoothen the process of data collection for academic audit which could then be seamlessly integrated with the regular functioning of the institution.
- A Two-Day National Conference titled, "Revisiting the Discourse on Women's Rights : New Forms of Violations & Contestations", was organized by the Gender issues Cell of the college in collaboration with Akshara, a Women's Resource Centre, on 1st and 2nd September 2016. This conference was partly sponsored by ICSSR. This inter-disciplinary National Conference focused on contemporary discourses on women's rights and how they engaged with new forms and expressions of gender violations and contestations, including the digital space.
- A One-Day National Conference on Dr Rajendra Prasad and his achievements was organized by the Department of Hindi on 3rd December 2016
