## **Q-rius Series Lecture-3**

**'Survey Based Research - Importance and Challenges'**

The 3<sup>rd</sup> lecture in the series of Q-rius, titled 'Survey Based Research-Importance and Challenges' was organized on 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2020, at 9:30 am by the Department of Life Sciences. It was attended by 49 participants including students and all the faculty members of the Life Sciences department. The resource person of the workshop was Mrs. Shailaja Rane, faculty from Department of Statistics, KC College. The program began with the welcome address given by Dr. Shalini Rai, the program coordinator, who outlined the objective of organizing such webinars on important topics that are helpful for students of Biological Sciences. Mrs. Shailaja Rane started with the basics of a statistical research. She simplified the meaning of survey based research and explained its importance. She outlined types of surveys such as Descriptive and Analytical and helped the participants in understanding the difference between Time based and Purposed based surveys. The session was followed by the Q and A session and Shailaja madam answered all the questions to the satisfaction of the students.
